She explained that thalassaemia affects the body's ability to produce healthy haemoglobin, causing weakness and fatigue in children who often require regular blood transfusions. Mrs. Singh also highlighted that children suffering from this condition are often unable to participate in physical activities like other children. Her talk helped students understand the importance of awareness, early testing, and compassion for those affected.

Students were encouraged to donate voluntarily for this noble cause. An impressive amount of ₹2,58,610 was collected. The highest collection was from Class 3C (Sudita Tr.) and Class 5A (Sunanda Damor Tr.). Individual prizes were awarded to Shlok S. Patel (5C), Priyanshi Rathod (5C), Manshree Gajjar (4B), and Hari Shree Gajjar (7B). Many students also received Certificates, medals, special trophy, pen, bat and skipping rope as prize. શારીરિક શિક્ષણ એ શિક્ષણનો જ એક ભાગ છે. શારીરિક શિક્ષણ વિષયમાં શરીરરચના વિષય દ્વારા શરીર કઈ રીતે કામ કરે છે તે જાણવા મળે છે. શરીરવિજ્ઞાન વિષયમાં રનાયુઓ કેવી રીતે કામ કરે છે તે જાણવા મળે છે. કિનેસિયોલોજી દ્વારા શરીર હલન-ચલન કેવી રીતે કરે છે તે જાણવા મળે છે. બાયો મિકેનિક્સ વિષય દ્વારા ટેકનિક સાચી છે કે ખોટી તે જાણી શકાય છે. રમતગમત મનોવિજ્ઞાન વિષય દ્વારા પ્રભાવમાં મગજને કેવી રીતે સંભાળવું એ શીખડાવે છે. પોષણ દ્વારા બાળકોએ/ખેલાડીઓએ શું ખાવું જોઈએ એ જાણવા મળે છે. તાલીમ પદ્ધતિ દ્વારા ખેલાડી / બાળકોનું કામગીરી કેવી રીતે વધારી શકાય તે જાણી શકાય છે.
